Non-Civil Service Vacancy

Senior Scene Crew (Set Design & Scenic Services Section, Production Services Division) (Salary: \$81 per hour, around 175 – 240 hours per month, depending on operational need)

Entry Requirements: Candidates should have –

- (a) a craft certificate in props making / scenic art / carpentry, or equivalent, from Hong Kong Institute of Vocational Education or Construction Industry Council Training Academy or technical institute / college, or equivalent; and 4 years' experience in set construction / decoration / TV or film production; OR
- (b) completed a recognised apprenticeship in props making / scenic art / carpentry, or equivalent; and 6 years' experience in set construction / decoration / TV or film production; OR
- (c) at least 8 years' experience in set construction / decoration / TV or film production.

Candidates who are able to read and write simple Chinese; speak fluent Cantonese; and able to understand simple English will have an advantage.

(Note: Candidates may be required to sit for a trade test.)

Duties: Responsible for (i) supervising and leading a team of Artisans and hired workers to build or strike the sets as indicated in design drawings; (ii) attending to props and set dressing on site; (iii) co-ordinating transportation and storage for set materials; and (iv) repairing and maintaining scenic elements and properties.

(Note: Successful candidates are required to work irregular hours and inclement weather.)

Terms of Appointment & Fringe Benefits: Successful candidate will be appointed on one-year non-civil service contract terms. Rest days, general holidays, annual leave, maternity leave, paternity leave, sickness allowance, where appropriate, will be granted on terms not less favourable than the provisions of the Employment Ordinance.

How to Apply: Application forms (G.F. 340 (Rev. 3/2013)) are obtainable from any Home Affairs Enquiry Centres of District Offices, Home Affairs Department or any Job Centre of the Employment Services Division, Labour Department. Completed forms should be sent to the address below on or before the closing date for application. Candidates who are selected for interview will normally receive an invitation in about 6 weeks from the closing date for application. Those who are not invited for interview may assume that their applications are unsuccessful. Only shortlisted candidates will be notified.

General Notes:

- (A) Candidates must be permanent residents of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region at the time of appointment unless specified otherwise.
- (B) As an Equal Opportunities Employer, the Government is committed to eliminating discrimination in employment. The vacancy advertised is open to all applicants meeting the basic entry requirements irrespective of their disability, sex, marital status, pregnancy, age, family status, sexual orientation and race.
- (C) Non-civil service vacancies are not posts on the civil service establishment. Candidates appointed are not on civil service terms of appointment and conditions of service. Candidates appointed are not civil servants and will not be eligible for posting, promotion or transfer to any posts in the Civil Service.
- (D) The entry pay, terms of appointment and conditions of service to be offered are subject to the provisions prevailing at the time the offer of appointment is made.
- (E) Where a large number of candidates meet the specified entry requirements, the recruiting department may devise shortlisting criteria to select the better qualified candidates for further processing. In these circumstances, only shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend recruitment examination and/or interview.
- (F) It is Government policy to place people with a disability in appropriate jobs wherever possible. If a disabled candidate meets the entry requirements, he/she will be invited to attend the selection interview/written examination without being subject to any further shortlisting criteria.
- (G) Holders of academic qualifications other than those obtained from Hong Kong institutions/Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority may also apply but their qualifications will be subject to assessments on equivalence with the required entry qualifications. They should submit copies of their official transcripts and certificates by mail to the above enquiry address.
